

Wedding Policy of Redeemer Lutheran Church 202 West Rudisill Boulevard Ft. Wayne, Indiana

The wedding and marriage policy of Redeemer Lutheran Church (Redeemer), a member congregation of The Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod (LCMS), is and always has been consistent with the Synod's beliefs on marriage. The congregation does not rent out or loan its facilities for weddings. The congregation provides weddings for its members at no cost to the couple on a first come, first served basis. Only one wedding can be scheduled for a weekend. If one of Redeemer's pastors is unable to perform the wedding an ordained minister on the roster of the LCMS may be allowed to conduct the wedding in Redeemer's building with the pastor of Redeemer or the Board of Elders' permission. No other clergy or persons shall be allowed to perform weddings at Redeemer. At least one of the persons being married must be a member in good standing during the engagement period, when the wedding is being planned, and also at the time of the wedding. If at any time during the planning process, up to and including the day of the wedding, the member comes under Church discipline or is removed from congregational membership the wedding will not be performed at Redeemer Lutheran Church.
