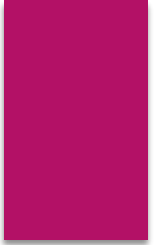

- (b) Description
- (c) Petition
- (d) Benefit desired
- (e) Doxology

- ▶ **Address:** Almighty and everlasting God,
 - ▶ **Description:** who hates nothing that You have made and forgives the sins of all those who are penitent,
 - ▶ **Petition:** create and make in us new and contrite hearts,
 - ▶ **Benefit:** that we, worthily lamenting our sins and acknowledging our wretchedness, may obtain of You, the God of all mercy, perfect remission and forgiveness;
 - ▶ **Doxology:** through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.


- ▶ Direction of the Celebrant

- ▶ Gospel

Ceremonies

- ▶ Sit, Stand
- ▶ The Lectern or Horn
- ▶ Gospel Procession
 - ▶ Blessing of the Deacon
 - ▶ Cross on the Book
 - ▶ Crosses on mind, lips, and heart
 - ▶ Head bows at the Name of Jesus
 - ▶ The Book of the Gospels
