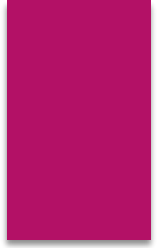

Lent 1- 4

- ▶ 40 days to Easter
- ▶ Penitence / Preparation / Catechesis
- ▶ Ash Wednesday – Day of Penance
- ▶ Violet / No Dalmatics or Tunicles / No Saints on Sundays
- ▶ No Alleluias or Gloria in Excelsis
- ▶ Laetare / Rose, dalmatic and tunicle back
- ▶ Fasting
- ▶ Midweek Services, suppers

Latin Names and the Gospels for Lent

- ▶ **INVOCABIT** “he will call.” Psalm 91: “He will call upon me and I will answer him. The Gospel is Our Lord’s temptation in the desert and the Psalmist gives voice to Our Lord’s prayer as He faces Satan in order to deliver us from evil.
- ▶ **REMINISCERE** “remember.” Psalm 25: “Remember, O Lord, Your tender mercies and Your loving-kindnesses.” The Gospel is the account of the Canaanite woman’s terrible battle with Our Lord for her demon-possessed daughter. The woman holds Our Lord to His Word. She insists that He remember His promises and be the Messiah.
- ▶ **OCULI** “My eyes.” Psalm 25: “Mine eyes are ever toward the Lord, for He shall pluck my feet out of the net.” The Gospel recounts the healing of a deaf and mute man. His eyes were rightly on the Lord.
- ▶ **LAETARE** “rejoice.” Isaiah 66 “Rejoice with Jerusalem, and be glad with her; all you who love her.” The Gospel is the feeding of the five thousand who had ample cause for rejoicing.
