



Of course, if you make it to a service, you can leave your offering in the plate in the narthex or chapel. The best way to contribute if you cannot make it to church is to use your bank's bill pay service. The bank just needs the name and address of the church and the amount you wish to give. Most banks offer this as a free service, and the church pays no fees. If you need a completely electronic option we do have a PayPal account, but be aware that the church does pay a fee. If you choose to use PayPal, please note the purpose of your donation when you make it. The word "offering" is sufficient description. The email address associated with our PayPal account is RedeemerFortWayne@gmail.com. There is also a "donate" button on each page of our website.

Also, if you have been making those electronic donations, don't forget that we have cards available in the narthex that say, "I give electronically" that you can put in the plate.

For the time being, we are going to have **two kinds of services that you can sign up for**. There will be larger services on Saturday and Sunday, as well as continued nine-person services on Saturday, and during the week. We are continuing the smaller, spoken services in the chapel for those who are more comfortable remaining in a smaller group at this time. Please don't sign up for both.
